Nature Plants, as one of the Nature Research journal, is an online-only, monthly journal publishing primary research concerning all aspects of plants. In addition to publishing original research, Nature Plants publishes magazine contents to provide a forum for the reporting and discussion of news and issues concerning plant science. All editorial decisions are made by a team of full-time professional editors with different expertise in plant research. The editorial standards and consideration, the publication pathway and criteria of Nature Plants as well as different Nature Research journals will be disclosed during the presentation.
