Her professional career included 10 years at the then World Agroforestry Centre, where she was especially assigned to do research on the evaluation of socio-economic and environmental viability of natural resource management within African smallholder systems. She joined JIRCAS in 2016, serving as Research Coordinator and Director of the Research Strategy Office, and since 2021 Program Director of the Information Program.
